

NATURE PLAY RECIPE CARD

Catching Raindrops

INGREDIENTS:

- Shells
- Big waxy leaves
- Buckets, boots, everything that holds water

METHOD:

- Wait until it rains.
- Get outside. You can introduce this by telling a story about how the water supply is dwindling and you need everyone to help collect water.
- You can even do this in teams to add some competitiveness.
- Experiment with different kinds of canisters and materials to see which one holds the most water like shells.
- You can build your own water catching system with big leaves.
- Use a measuring jug to see who has caught the most

SAFETY AND CARE:

- There is no such thing as bad weather, just bad clothing.
- Get some towels ready for when the kids get back inside.
- Get your leaves from the ground not from the plant. It needs them.

Rainforest plants have big wide leaves so that the rain can run off them.
